Dress Code Reminders

With the warmer weather here are a few reminders from the School Dress Code policy: In order to maintain a safe learning environment, students must be dressed for success. This includes, and may not be limited to the following: Clothes are to fit appropriately and not sag, no hanging belts or chains, skirts and dresses must be fingertip length or longer, no low-cut or revealing shirts, no bare-midriffs, halter tops or spaghetti straps, underclothes should be concealed and essential body parts covered, no sandals without straps-thongs-high heeled shoes, appropriate shoes (tennis shoes preferred) need to be worn for participation in PE activities, head coverings are not permitted inside the classroom or cafeteria and must be worn forward at all times.
