California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress

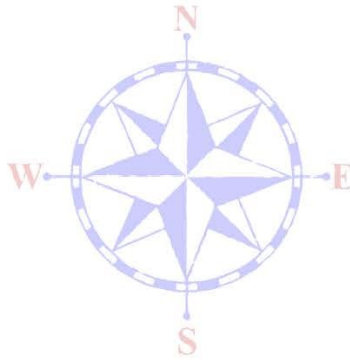

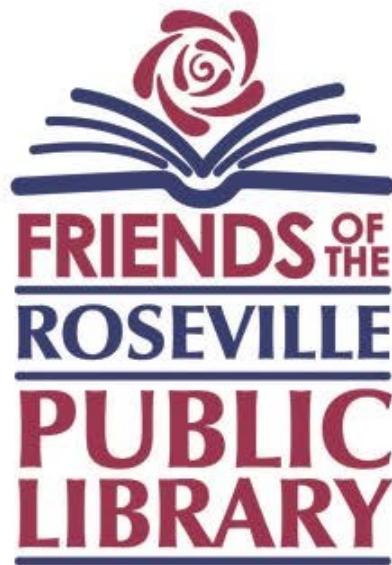

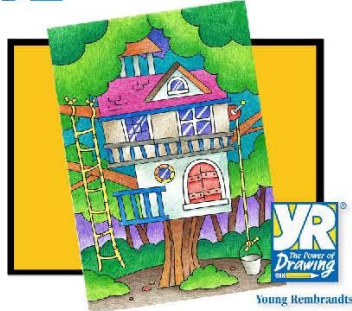
