A Message from Mrs. Patrick

Just a reminder that parents are welcome to sit and have an occasional lunch with their child as long as the intent is to share a "special" lunch with their own student. Parents are not permitted to be on the playground at recess due to safety issues and social concerns. We have adult employees on duty when the kids are playing to ensure they are properly supervised and safe. This policy is for the safety of all our students, staff and visitors. Lunch time provides opportunities for children to learn to interact with others and become more independent and autonomous.

If your child has an issue on the playground, we have a system in place to address it. Please discuss these problem solving steps with your family in order to ensure that you, your family, and your student has the proper support needed in case a situation arises:

- Try to take care of the problem by yourself. First try to ignore or avoid the person causing the problem. Next, use your words to discuss the issue with the person involved. Finally, you might have to use a strong voice: "LEAVE ME ALONE!" then walk away. If the problem still persists, it's time to ask an adult for help. This does not mean that you do not tell a parent. Mom or Dad need to know what is going on during the school day and that you are taking care of it the right way. Sometimes just talking it out will help you feel better about your problem.
- Ask the adult on duty or your teacher to intervene. Adults are here to help you talk ٠ your problems out when you cannot talk them out by yourself. Sometimes another student will not listen to you, but will take the adult seriously even when that adult says the same thing to you. Let the adult know what steps you have taken to end the problem so they know it is time to step in.
- If the problem still exists after every other path to resolution has been exhausted, it is ٠ time to talk to the principal. The principal has lots of ways to help with communication, safety and esteem issues. We want you to be able to feel safe, have friends and be happy.

There is a learning process children must go through to be able to be more socially responsible and self sufficient. Much like academics, it comes easy for some students and not so much for others. If we give our kids the opportunity to be more proactive in their own problem solving, and help them get the skills needed for all kinds of interactions, they will be more confident in life.
