A Message from Mrs. Patrick

As we enter the last nine weeks of school it is time again to do some parking lot reminders! With almost 580 students all dismissed at the same time a crowd is expected, but the good news is we are cleared out in less than 10 minutes. The not so good news is that it only takes a few misguided drivers to slow the entire process down, or worst, make dismissal unsafe. To ensure the safety of all our students, please adhere to the following guidelines so you can be part of the solution in keeping our children safe:

- Follow the Crossing Guards' instructions and yield to the pedestrians.
- When walking, use the crosswalk and the sidewalks when entering or leaving campus.
- Park ONLY in a designated parking spot or on the road where it is not red.
- Form a single line in the LARGE LOOP and continue to move forward as the line progresses. Do not leave your car unattended for any reason.
- Use the SMALL LOOP **only** if you have a kindergarten or 1st grade student. Form a single line and continue to move forward as the line progresses. Do not leave your car unattended for any reason.
- Do not use the staff parking lot to pick up/drop off or wait for your child. This is a bus stop zone for our severely handicapped students.
- Obey the signs: Right turns only, do not stop in the loading zone.
- Teach your child to enter and exit your car on the curb side out of the way of traffic.
- Keep your speed at a safe minimum and put away your cell phone.
- Arrange for an exit plan and have your child meet you at a designated area on a daily basis.
- Pick your child up on time, within 15 minutes of the bell.

Thank you for your assistance in following these simple rules to continue to keep your children safe!






