Please mark your calendar for minimum day schedule Tuesday May 28, Wednesday May 29, and Thursday May 30th, with all 1st through 5th grade students dismissed at 1:45 pm and all Kindergarten 9 am - 2 pm. TK class remains the same at 8:00 - 11:20 am.

As always, we will not be accepting requests for teachers for next school year. When we construct classes we try our best to set up lists that are balanced and heterogeneous. There are several factors that need to be considered when placing children in classes. Some but not all of those factors include a child's individual needs, academic ability, combination of students, and boy/girl ratio.





Dear Parents or Guardians,

The Roseville City School District (RCSD) is currently in the process of evaluating 6th-8th-grade state-approved History/Social Science curriculums, which will be piloted by our teachers in the fall and winter of 2019/2020. Before we choose which curriculums we will pilot, we would like to provide time for parents/guardians to review the curriculum options and provide feedback. We will offer two parent review nights, Monday, June 3rd and Wednesday, June 5th from 4:00 pm-6:00 pm at the Roseville City School District Office.

The parent review nights will offer a two-hour window for parents/guardians to come to the District Office and review the curriculum options. During this time, you will get the opportunity to look through all four state-approved curriculum options for each grade level 6th-8th, ask questions concerning the curriculum options and we will offer comment cards to capture your feedback. Roseville City School District values our families input and feels it is essential for you to get the opportunity to review and provide input regarding the future curriculum that will be taught in your child's classroom. Your feedback will be utilized by staff as part of the information used in selecting which two curricula to pilot. Below is a list of the four state-approved History/Social Science curriculum options under review:

Teachers' Curriculum Institute: History Alive! California Series


