A Message from Mrs. Patrick

Happy New Year! We are back into the swing of a regular school schedule and our students have started 2020 with enthusiasm. As a staff, we are glad to be experiencing this time of their lives with them!

As we begin the new year, we would like to encourage you to persuade and support your child to read for 30 minutes every day. Reading is one of the rudimentary “Three Rs” and is the cornerstone for all subjects of learning. The better your child reads, the more power he/she will have in almost every aspect of school. Reading is also a learned skill that takes practice and, at times, patience. To make it interesting, it is important to make it easy for your child to gravitate toward reading. Here are a few pointers:

- ◆ Make your home a reading friendly place. Keep books, magazines and even newspaper articles easily available in subjects that appeal to your child. A brightly lit, cozy reading spot away from distraction will encourage getting lost in a good book.
- ◆ Limit TV and video game time. This is easier said than done for many families, but could be tied to reading. Turn on the closed captioning when watching your favorite show; use the “thirty minutes of reading equals tube time” rule; if your child finds a specific type of program or game interesting, find related reading materials.
- ◆ Don’t forget about the library. Get your child a library card as soon as they reach the age limit. Taking a trip to the library can be like a treasure hunt to find books on subjects you would not otherwise consider looking into. Talk to the librarian about all the different materials available to help spark your child’s interest in reading.
- ◆ Let your child’s enthusiasm and curiosity be his guide.
- ◆ Most importantly, be an active part of the reading process. Talk about what your child is reading. Talk about something that you have read and enjoyed. Read out loud. Kids love to both read and be read to out loud. Take turns reading a chapter book, then finish up with a quick question/answer session.

Let your child read at his/her level. At school, our students read to learn. At home, your child should read for pleasure. Pushing your child to read at a level higher than his capability can be counterproductive both academically and emotionally. Active and supported learning is the best path to reading success!

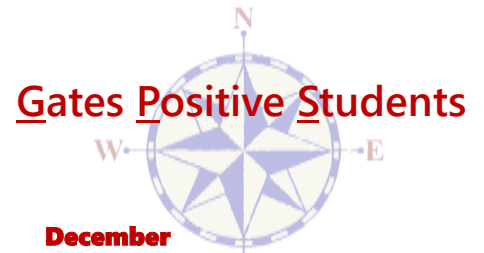
