A Message from Mrs. Patrick

Parent/Teacher Conferences are the week of November 4-8, and the students' first trimester report cards will be handed out. This is a pivotal time for parents and teachers to collaborate on ways to make our students' school year as successful as possible. It is also an excellent opportunity for parents to find out how their child is adjusting to the school year and to get to know the teachers and classroom expectation. Please take a moment to review the information provided on our website www.rcsdk8.org (click on parents) about the report card format and assessment system.

Here are some general hints on how to have a successful conference:

Talk with your child before the conference. Let him/her know this is a routine meeting all parents attend and the purpose is to discuss ways to help him/her in school. Ask your child if there are any specific concerns about school work or relationships with classmates that should be discussed with the teacher.

Jot down and prioritize everything you want to talk about at the conference. This is the time to bring up concerns or questions about homework, class work, academic level and abilities, classroom behavior and social skills. If your child needs help in any area, ask for suggestions on materials or resources you can access. Avoid lengthy discussions on topics that are not related to the purpose of the conference. If needed, you can schedule a separate time to meet and discuss those matters.

Arrive on time (if not a few minutes early). Each conference is allotted a limited number of minutes. Being late will shorten your time with your child's teacher and affect the day's entire schedule. Do not stay beyond your scheduled time as the meetings usually run back to back.

Ask guestions if you do not understand something or feel your concerns are not being understood. Teachers may use acronyms and forget that you are not familiar with them. Do not be afraid to stop and ask for an explanation of unfamiliar terms or programs as needed. Ask what test scores mean and what the results mean for your child.

Take notes about what has been discussed and share them with your child. Start with the positive things the teacher had to say, then fill him/her in on any concerns you and the teacher discussed. Explain how you can all work together to ensure your child has a successful year.

Find out the best way to communicate and follow up with concerns. Your child's teacher may want to stay in touch through email or phone calls so you can have a system in place that makes communication easy to follow. Ask about the easiest way to access homework assignments or class schedules.

Step-By-Step Parent/Guardian Conference Scheduling Instructions

Between **October 24th and November 1st** you will have the opportunity to schedule your Parent-Teacher conference(s) online. To make your conference appointment, please follow the instructions below.

Go to the district homepage **www.rcsdl&.org**, click on Schools, click on Gates and once on the school site click on Menu, then select the Online Scheduler link under Resources.

From the Online Scheduler Home Page:

- * Choose Gates school from the drop down list and click "GO"
- * Enter the school password: explorer
- Enter your child's "Student ID" number. If you do not have the Student ID, use the LOOK UP STUDENT ID button to access the system.
- * Verify your child's date of birth.
- * A list of teachers will be displayed. Check the box next to the name of each teacher(s) you would like to meet with.
- If you have more than one student in the school you can see all of your children's teachers' schedules at one time by answering YES to this question: "Do you want to schedule conferences for another student?" then repeat the steps above for your other children. If you only have one child, answer NO to that question.
- * You will then see the available time slots for each teacher you selected.
- * Select the times that work best for your schedule.
- Enter your email address (<u>highly recommended</u>) if you would like an email reminder sent to you. (Your email address is kept private)
- Once you have finished you can confirm your appointment details and print your conference schedule.
- Write down the Confirmation Number (<u>you will need this number if you need to cancel your</u> <u>appointment</u>).

2020 GATE Identification

The 2020-2021 school year GATE identification test will be administered at the District Office for students currently in 2nd – 7th grade. The students will take the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test, OLSAT, that tests abstract thinking and reasoning ability. Students must attend one of the testing dates on the OLSAT Parent Permission Form in order to complete the testing by the district. The Parent Permission Forms are on our district website @ www.rcsdk8.org Click on the Main Menu and then under Programs – Gifted and Talented Education. All forms *must* be returned to the District Office by December 20, 2019 if you would like your student tested. There are *no exceptions* as materials are ordered based on the number of returned forms. Make sure you check the RCSD website for more information regarding GATE services and testing.
