A Message from Mrs. Patrick

Happy Fall Gates Families! As we move toward November I encourage you to plan on attending a parent teacher conference the week of November 5 - 9. We all lead busy lives and this is a wonderful opportunity to have a focused conversation regarding the progress of your student. Please refer to the enclosed flyer with instructions on how to schedule your Parent-Teacher conference online. The online scheduler will be available starting October 25th.

Parent-Teacher conference time also reminds us how important communication is in our community. While e-mail is often the most convenient form (because as I mentioned before we have busy lives) it is not always the one that provides the most clarity to arrive at a resolution regarding a concern. Therefore here are a few helpful hints to remind all of us (staff, parents, community members, etc.) about how we should communicate with each other when using e-mail:

- Keep it short and to the point. Clearly state the concern, seek understanding
 of the situation and provide any relevant information to help the person
 problem solve.
- Remember to not send e-mails when emotionally charged! Draft an e-mail in the moment to ensure your thoughts are down, but revisit later to rework if needed to ensure clarity of the communication. It is always good practice to have someone review it before hitting send.

The goal is always to have open and honest communication. Of course, if the situation warrants, please schedule a conference with the teacher to discuss any issues. Thank you so much for your support with your child's education as we all strive to do what is best for them.

Step-By-Step Parent/Guardian Conference Scheduling Instructions

Between **October 25th and November 2nd** you will have the opportunity to schedule your Parent-Teacher conference(s) online. To make your conference appointment, please follow the instructions below.

Go to the district homepage **www.rcsdk8.org**, click on Schools, click on Gates and once on the school site click on Menu, then select the Online Scheduler link under Resources.

From the Online Scheduler Home Page:

- * Choose Gates school from the drop down list and click "GO"
- * Enter the school password: explorer
- * Enter your child's "Student ID" number. If you do not have the Student ID, use the LOOK UP STUDENT ID button to access the system.
- Verify your child's date of birth.
- A list of teachers will be displayed. Check the box next to the name of each teacher(s) you
 would like to meet with.
- If you have more than one student in the school you can see all of your children's teachers' schedules at one time by answering YES to this question: "Do you want to schedule conferences for another student?" then repeat the steps above for your other children. If you only have one child, answer NO to that question.
- * You will then see the available time slots for each teacher you selected.
- * Select the times that work best for your schedule.
- Enter your email address (<u>highly recommended</u>) if you would like an email reminder sent to you. (Your email address is kept private)
- Once you have finished you can confirm your appointment details and print your conference schedule.
- Write down the Confirmation Number (<u>you will need this number if you need to cancel your</u> <u>appointment</u>).
