A Message from Mrs. Patrick

Our students are settling into a routine of learning, achieving and continuing to make Catheryn Gates School a great place to learn. Part of our success is due to the families who have partnered with Gates' School to make our students successful learners. You are appreciated and your support does not go unnoticed! Let's continue the quest to make this another great year.

Volunteer Information:

Parking Lot Standards:

Yes, our parking lot is a discombobulated mass of cars and kids at the end of the day! With about 550 students all dismissed at the same time a crowd is expected, but the good news is we are cleared out in less than 10 minutes. The not so good news is that it only takes a few misguided drivers to slow the entire process down, or worst, make dismissal unsafe. To ensure the safety of all our students, please adhere to the following guidelines so you can be part of the solution in keeping our children safe:

- Follow the Crossing Guards' instructions and yield to the pedestrians.
- When walking, use the crosswalk and the sidewalks when entering or leaving campus.
- Park ONLY in a designated parking spot or on the school side of Trehowell Drive.
- Form a single line in the LARGE LOOP and continue to move forward as the line progresses. **Do not leave your car unattended for any reason**.
- Use the SMALL LOOP only if you have a kindergarten or 1st grade student. Form a single line and continue to move forward as the line progresses. **Do not leave your car unattended for any reason.**
- Do not use the staff parking lot to pick up/drop off or wait for your child. This is a bus stop zone for our severely handicapped students.
- Obey the signs: Right turns only, do not stop in the loading zone.
- Teach your child to enter and exit your car on the curb side out of the way of traffic.
- Turn off your cell phone.
- Keep your speed at a safe minimum. There have been complaints of speeding from our neighbors. When parking in the neighborhood do not block driveways or park in them.
- Arrange for an exit plan and have your child meet you at a designated area on a daily basis.
- Remind your child to wear a helmet when riding a bike or scooter to school.
- Pick your child up on time. We still have students left up to 30 minutes after the bell.
- Have a plan with your child about pick up BEFORE they come to school.

We thank you for your continued assistance with this and keeping all students safe!
